TOUR THE PRINCE GALLITZIN CHAPEL HOUSE:

The historic Prince Gallitzin Chapel House, next to the Our Lady of the Alleghenies Shrine, will be open on the following Sunday afternoons from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. for self-guided tours, pilgrimages and visits on July 21, August 4 and August 18. **Demetrius Augustine Gallitzin** (Dec. 22, 1770 to May 6, 1840) is known as “The Apostle of the Alleghenies.” On June, 2005, he was named a *Servant of God* by the Congregation for Causes of Saints, a first step toward sainthood.
