2ND COLLECTION: This weekend **Nov. 19/20** is for **Catholic Charities of our diocese** which is used to help anyone in a crisis regardless of religious affiliation.

2022 MINISTRIES DRIVE (CMD): Our goal for the diocese is \$9,281.00. As of **October 31**, we have received **\$10,585.00** in cash and pledges; plus **\$2,620.00** directly to us for the doors.
