STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION: *In today's Gospel, the instructions to the apostles continue, as Jesus offered them this warning: "Fear no one ... do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul."* This passage offers all of us a simple but bold reminder that discipleship isn't easy. It entails risk. It involves sacrifice. And it demands courage. This is where it starts: "Do not be afraid." The first Christians learned quickly that following The Way of Jesus brought trouble — hardship, imprisonment, torture, even death. Standing up for the teachings of Christ today can still cause conflict. Today is a good opportunity to ask ourselves just what we are called to do, what kinds of people we are called to be, and how we can best follow more closely in the footsteps of Jesus. Sometimes, that can come with a cost.

2nd COLLECTION: Next weekend, June 27-28 we will have the **Peter's Pence Collection**, a significant way to support the Universal Church. This collection funds the ongoing activities of the Holy See and helps the Holy Father reach out to people suffering in our world.

CATHOLIC MINISTRIES DRIVE (CMD) 2026: This year's theme, *Sent to Serve*, reminds us that, by virtue of our baptism, each of us has been *Sent to Serve*, entrusted with gifts that are meant to be shared for the good of others. This drive supports 9 ministries in our diocese, under evangelization, serving those in need, or formation of priests and deacons. This year our diocesan goal is **\$9,200**. Everything over that will be used for our project of replacing our entrance sign. As of **May 31**, we have received **\$8,320** in cash and pledges to the diocese and **\$565** directly for our project.

ASSISTING CREATURES IN NEED: The service project for June, July and August will benefit homeless animals. All monetary donations will be divided between two local animal welfare organizations. **Tiny Paws** provides lifesaving intervention for kittens who have been abandoned by their mothers. **Abby's Angels** uses the foster care model to provide rescue and rehabilitation for dogs. All donations of food will be delivered to the **Bedford County Humane Society**. All types and brands of food are accepted. Donation bins are in the vestibule.
