
Confessions: Saturday: 12:00 noon, Sunday: 8:00 a.m., after Holy Hour, after Mass, or any time by appointment.

2ND COLLECTION: Every 3 years we have a National Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Service. This falls on Nov. 8/9. The mission of this Archdiocese is to ensure that service members of all 6 branches, Veterans, and their families be able to seek sacramental preparation for baptism, confirmation, first Communion, penance and marriage; to benefit from consultation with a priest, and to receive the sacrament of penance as they defend our rights of freedom of speech. AMS also Co-sponsors a Seminarian Program that provides priests to serve as military chaplains.
